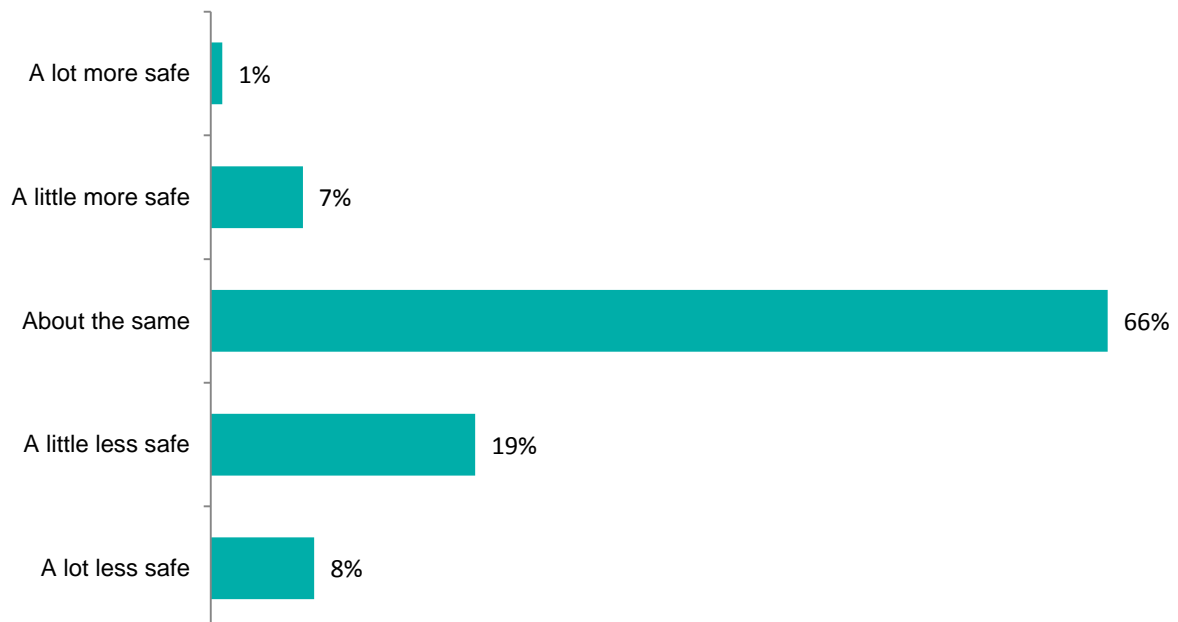
Community Voice Quick Poll: Community Safety

This Quick Poll asked Community Voice members about their feelings of safety as they go about daily life. The results will inform further research and will help shape the Community Safety Action Plan 2020-2022.

Community Voice is an online group of 559 residents who broadly represent the Glen Eira community in terms of age, gender and suburb. The Quick Poll ran from 2 to 16 September 2019. 238 members completed the poll, which is a response rate of 43%.

Findings

Q1 Compared to two years ago, how safe do you feel at home and in your neighbourhood?



What will Council do next?

The results of the Quick Poll give some insight into how safe Glen Eira residents feel in their homes and neighbourhoods. For most, their feelings of safety have not changed much over the past two years. However, a significant number (27%) feel either a little less, or a lot less safe than they did two years ago.

Council's next step will be to conduct further research, to understand why members of the community feel less safe, and what they do to feel safer. We will then talk to the community about what we have learned, and develop strategies and actions to include in the next Community Safety Action Plan 2020-2022.
